Speed Networking: How It Works

Have a job position or multiple positions you need to fill and don't have time to do all the legwork in finding available freelancers yourself? We'll do it for you! Sponsor your very own private Speed Networking Event and we'll hand pick the freelancers and bring them to you at this invite only event!

The chosen freelancers will arrive with portfolio and business cards in hand, to share with you during a timed sit-down interview. You can choose the time allotment as we set up your event, however, 5-10 minutes is recommended for each interview.

STEP 1 Tell Us What You Need

Tell SLICE the kind of positions you're looking to fill, your timeline, level of experience you want, etc.



STEP 2 SLICE Will Find Them!

The SLICE Board of Advisors will contact freelancers who match your needs, with a careful attention to quality of work and level of experience.



STEP 3 SLICE Hosts Event

SLICE will host a private Speed Networking Event, where you will meet and interview with all of the freelancers who match your needs, in one easy event. You determine the length of interview time, however, 5-10 minutes is recommended.



STEP 4 You Keep all Leads!

You keep all of the contact information for all of the applicants you interviewed for follow up interviews or project involvement, and you just saved yourself hours and hours of unnecessary research and interview time! Hooray!
